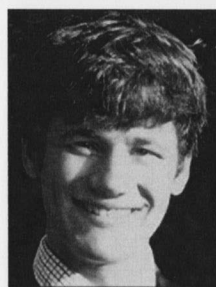


Welcome Trinity Fellows Class of 2009

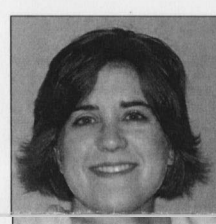

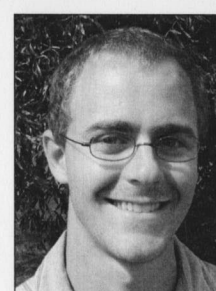

 Melissa was a Young Life volunteer team leader in Dallas and served as a member of the National Youth Leadership Forum on Medicine.



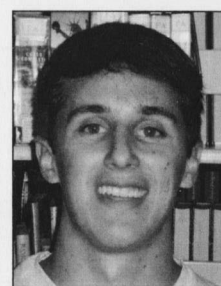

 Jenny studied in France and worked in the Republic of Congo doing an internship with HOPE International. She is interested in doing community development work. She loves traveling and the outdoors.



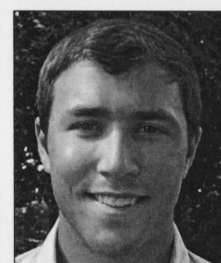
